

POLICY

NONINSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

The Holmdel Township Board of Education recognizes the importance of supportive services to the operation of the school district and the achievement of district and school educational goals.

The Board directs the Superintendent to ensure the provision of sufficient and appropriate supportive services which may include, but are not limited to:

- A. Secretarial and clerical;
- B. Custodial;
- C. Buildings and grounds maintenance;
- D. Food services;
- E. Pupil transportation;
- F. Instructional aides; and
- G. School monitors.

Support services are essential to the successful functioning of a school system and management of auxiliary operations is an important responsibility. It should be remembered, however, that education is the district's central function and all support services shall be provided, guided and evaluated accordingly.
