

## TRANSPORTATION

The Holmdel Township Board of Education shall provide school bus transportation for pupils in conformance with all state laws and rules and regulations of the State Board of Education or the policies and regulations of the Holmdel Township Board of Education.

All kindergarten through eighth grade students, even those who live within two (2) miles from the school (less than remote) shall be transported. All ninth through twelfth grade students who live within two and one-half (2 1/2) miles from the school (less than remote) shall be transported.

The Holmdel Township Board of Education has determined that the following bus routes are necessary because of unsafe/hazardous walking conditions for the students:

### High School

Bus Routes - 21, 23, 25, 27, 31, 33, 35, 37, 43, 45, 49, 51, and 53

### William R. Satz School

Bus Routes - 59, 63, 65, 67, 71, 73, 85, 87, and 89

### Indian Hill School

Bus Routes - 1, 7, 19, and 135

### Village School

Bus Routes - 103, 105, 111, and 123

All Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten Routes

The rationale for this determination can be enumerated as follows: no sidewalks, no shoulders for pedestrian traffic, county roads and state highways.

The Assistant Superintendent in Charge of Business/Board Secretary, in conjunction with the Coordinator of Transportation, shall be responsible to the Superintendent for the management of pupil transportation. He/she shall recommend bus routes to the Board, and shall specify bus schedules and determine bus stops in cooperation with school principals and with approval of the Superintendent. Hazardous routes and stops shall be avoided whenever possible.

School bus insurance and safety requirements established by the state shall be observed. The administration may establish other requirements as it deems necessary.

### Pupils with Educational Disabilities

Transportation to and from school will be provided by the district for every pupil resident in the district who is identified as an educationally disabled pupil and whose individualized education program (IEP) requires such transportation, whether or not the disabled pupil is attending schools of the district or public schools anywhere in the state, or private schools as authorized under provisions of the law subject to approval by the office of the county superintendent.

### Nonpublic School Pupils

Transportation shall be provided to eligible pupils attending nonpublic schools in accordance with state law. The parents/guardians of nonpublic school pupils are required to make application for transportation prior to the close of the school year preceding the school year for which the aid is being requested.
