

NONSCHOOL EMPLOYMENT

School employees shall not engage in outside activities or perform personal services for compensation during the hours of the prescribed school day.

No outside work by a staff member shall prevent his/her from properly performing assigned functions during duty hours or be prejudicial to his/her work effectiveness.
