

POLICY

NONINSTRUCTIONAL AIDES

The Holmdel Township Board of Education within its financial means may hire noninstructional aides, known as school or classroom “monitors”, as recommended by the Superintendent to address needs of student management with the regular and/or special education students.

All noninstructional monitors will carry out their responsibilities under the supervision of appropriate by administrative staff.

Job descriptions for monitors must be submitted to and approved by the Monmouth County Superintendent of Schools. All noninstructional aides shall be required to comply with the provisions of state and federal law regarding health and security checks.
