

### **SOCIAL EVENTS/MEETINGS**

The Holmdel Township Board of Education believes that social activities in school life assist pupils in learning how to enjoy worthwhile group events, how to conduct themselves, and how to contribute to the enjoyment of others. Therefore school groups and classes may hold social events for their membership with proper authorization and under staff supervision, using school facilities.

The principal and the teaching staff shall evaluate social events in terms of contributions to pupil growth and morale and shall develop procedures for scheduling and conducting such events, including proper chaperonage.

School organizations holding dances and other social functions will provide for adequate police protection to control traffic, to protect parking areas during the function, and to be on call as necessary for guarding the welfare of the guests. The Superintendent must be notified by the building principal whenever police protection is requested for a school function.

The pupil conduct code shall be in force at all social events.
