

### CLASS SIZE

The Holmdel Township Board of Education believes that class size and effective grouping of pupils influence the quality of instruction. In establishing expected class sizes annually, the administration will take into consideration such factors as pupil needs, curriculum requirements, type of instructional setting, district finances and space or equipment limitations.

Particular attention shall be paid to new construction space-per-pupil requirements of the state department of education.
