Reader and Writer Workshop I, Incoming 1st and 2nd Grades

This course is designed for incoming first and second graders. Through formal instruction, hands-on activities, as well as play, students will work to improve their phonics, words building skills and solidify reading and writing skills. Using themes, students will be engaged in activities that will develop reading fluency, expand their sight word vocabulary, strengthen their ability to segment words into sounds, blend individual sounds into words, and identify rhyming words. Guided reading lessons will develop student's sense of self esteem as they find reading and writing success.

The finished product will be a portfolio of essays that have successfully completed the writing process.

This course introduces the science of chemistry. A major emphasis is placed on the use of dimensional analysis as an approach to problem solving. Students will learn both the mathematics and the nomenclature of Chemistry. #226B is for students who will be taking Principles of Chemistry.

Topics and Strategies to Improve NJ ASK 7 & 8 Performance, Incoming 7th and 8th Grades

Students will become familiar with the NJ ASK 7 & 8 exam. They will be exposed to practice tests and learn creative test taking strategies. Through the exploration of open ended questions, students will become more confident in communicating mathematically. The state rubric will be discussed and students will become comfortable with what is required in a good open ended response.

The New SAT: Test Taking Strategies for the New Writing Section and Math Prep, Incoming 10th - 12th Grades

Since the inception of the new SAT, the newly introduced writing section has been of great concern for both students and parents alike. This course will expose students to the format for the new SAT writing section by viewing samples, using the 6 point holistic rubric and writing SAT type responses with teacher feedback. HSPA writing will also be addressed in order for the students to understand the distinction between the two tests.

Authors include Swift, Shakespeare, Twain, Welty, Shelley, Wells, Orwell, London, Achebe, Melville Dumas and Hesse.
