

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE IN GUIDANCE AS OF 4/16/10

Alexandra Rose Miracle Academic Scholarship – April 30, 2010 deadline.

One \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior with a GPA of 3.6 or better who has been accepted to a college/university for the fall of 2010. Applicants must have participated in a school sport as an athlete, statistician, manager, etc., or in the arts via dance, theater, visual arts, instrumental or vocal music at Holmdel HS. Transcript and essay required.

Brookdale Community College Scholarships – May 3, 2010 deadline.

The following scholarships are offered to seniors who will attend Brookdale Community College in the fall of 2010.

- Brookdale Community College Alumni Association Youth Opportunity Scholarship for seniors who will be attending Brookdale full-time (earning 12 credits or more) during the fall 2010 semester
- T.J. Bruno Scholarship for Students with Disabilities
- Officer Kenneth F. Tietjen Memorial Scholarship for students majoring in Criminal Justice
- Buck Smith Endowed Memorial Scholarship for students residing in Monmouth County
- Wilbur Ray Scholarship for minority students with a career interest in law enforcement or a related field.

Catherine Dean Community Service Scholarship – April 30, 2010 deadline.

This \$1,000 scholarship is offered to seniors enrolling in a two- or four-year college/university in September 2010. Selection will be based on GPA, essay, character, and demonstrated leadership.

Chief Ralph Molzon Memorial Scholarship – May 7, 2010 deadline.

An award of \$250 is offered to graduating seniors who demonstrate evidence of community service and are planning to pursue post-high school education or specialized training. Essay required.

Create-A-Greeting Card Scholarship Contest - see website for deadline information.

Dante Alighieri Women's Society Scholarship – April 24, 2010 deadline.

Two \$2,000 scholarships are offered to seniors of Italian-American descent. Transcript, SAT scores, and essay required.

Holmdel Alliance to Prevent Alcoholism & Drug Abuse Scholarship – May 4, 2010 deadline.

College-bound seniors in good academic standing may apply for three merit-based scholarships: one (1) \$500 scholarship, and two (2) \$250 scholarships. Winners will be selected on the basis of their extracurricular/community involvement, a written personal statement, and transcript.

Holmdel Creative Arts Association Scholarships – April 19, 2010 deadline.

The following scholarships are available to seniors who have a minimum 3.0 GPA, have been accepted at an undergraduate college, and meet the criteria set forth for each scholarship.

- Alexandra Rose Miracle Arts Scholarship
- Art Scholarship
- Drama Scholarship
- Graphic Art and/or Computer Animation Scholarship
- Television Production Scholarship.

Holmdel Pop Warner Greg Preziose and Matthew Picerno Scholarships – May 3, 2010 deadline.

Seniors who have had high school football and Pop Warner experience may apply for the Greg Preziose Scholarship. Seniors who have had high school and Pop Warner cheerleading experience may apply for the Matthew Picerno Scholarship. Essay required.

Howard Porter Memorial Scholarship – May 1, 2010 deadline.

Seniors who will pursue a college degree in the study of Criminal Justice, Law, Social Service, Government, or a related field may apply for this \$1,000 scholarship. Applicants must be active in school extracurricular activities and at least one police/community activity. Transcript and essay required.

Italian American Association of Monmouth County Scholarship – April 30, 2010 deadline.

College-bound seniors of Italian descent with a GPA of 3.0 or better may apply for one of three \$1,000 scholarships. Transcript, two (2) letters of recommendation, and essay required.

Jon M. Pritsch Memorial Golf Fund Scholarship – May 25, 2010 deadline.

Students who have played on Holmdel High School's golf team and wish to pursue a career in a golf-related field may apply for this scholarship. Applicants must have been accepted to either the Professional Golf Management Program or a School of Agronomy to be a Greens Superintendent. Essay, and letter of recommendation from a coach is required, along with a letter from the golf pro where you play golf.

Marine Trades Association of NJ Scholarships – see applications for deadline information.

Two scholarships are available to students interested in pursuing a career in the marine industry: The MTA/NJ Education Scholarship is valued at \$3,000; the Automotive Training Center Scholarship is a full (\$18,000) scholarship for the Marine Service Technology program at the Automotive Training Center in Pennsylvania. Master Gardeners of Monmouth County Scholarship – June 30, 2010 deadline.

Seniors planning to enroll in a horticulture program at a New Jersey college or university for the fall 2010 semester may apply for this \$1,000 scholarship. Applicants must have demonstrated an interest in horticulture through class work, employment, community service and/or extracurricular activities. Transcript, two letters of recommendations are required.

Monmouth County Sheriff Youth Week Program – June 15, 2010 deadline.

This free week-long program runs from July 12-16, from 7:45 am to 4:00 pm daily. It offers interested students an opportunity to explore interests in law enforcement through police academy-style training, physical fitness and instructional sessions. Signed permission slip and completed physical form required.

National Kitchen & Bath Association Bill Farnan Scholarship – May 17, 2010 deadline.

Three (3) \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded to students pursuing a college degree in Design. Transcript, resume/work record for past two (2) years, reference, and essay required.

Nordstrom Scholarship Program – May 15, 2010 deadline.

Juniors with a GPA of 2.7 or better are eligible to apply for this \$10,000 scholarship. Applicants must be active in community or volunteer activities, be in need of financial assistance for college, and eligible to attend a four-year college or university in the U.S. Scholarship applications may be downloaded at Nordstrom.com/scholarship.

Race for Education Equine and Agriculture Industries Scholarships – see scholarships for deadlines.

Sandra M. Glazier Memorial Scholarship – May 1, 2010 deadline.

This \$20,000 scholarship is offered to seniors who are battling cancer or have a parent who is afflicted with the disease. Applicants must be accepted at a college or vocational school for the fall of 2010. Three (3) essays, two (2) letters of recommendation and a letter from a treating physician, transcript, and copy of college acceptance letter required.

Ted Engberg Conservation Scholarship – May 1, 2010 deadline.

Students accepted to a four-year college/university for the fall of 2010 who will major in a conservation-related field (botany, biology, forestry, environmental studies, teacher/naturalist, etc.) may apply for this \$1,500 scholarship. Transcript, letter of college acceptance, and essay required.

Thornton Sisters Foundation Scholarship – May 7, 2010 deadline.

A one-year educational scholarship is offered to senior women of color who will enter a four-year accredited college or university in the fall of 2010. Transcript, three (3) letters of recommendation, essay, photograph, proof of college acceptance, and copy of parents' Income Tax statement required.

XX Olympiad Memorial Award – May 1, 2010 deadline.

This award will be presented to an outstanding senior scholar-athlete. Selection will be based on athletic achievement, scholarship, leadership and community service.
