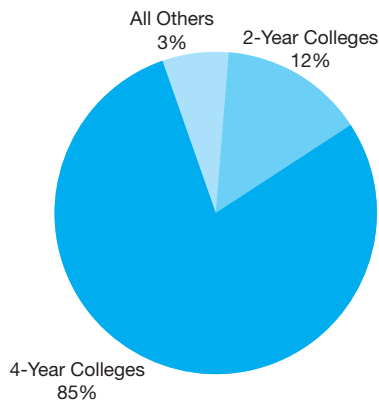

ADVANCED PLACEMENT

In May 2009, 256 students took a total of 704 Advanced Placement exams with 91% of the students scoring 3, 4 or 5. The school AP average grade is 4.0.

Grade point average (GPA) is calculated at the end of the fourth, sixth, seventh, and eighth semesters. Honors (H) and Advanced Placement (AP) courses are awarded an additional quality point for grades of C or better. All GPAs are cumulative.

In 1992, the Holmdel Township Board of Education approved the decision to eliminate the ranking of students.

After 6 semesters, members of the Class of 2010 have earned GPAs as follows:

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All students must earn a minimum of 120 credits, which include:

English	4 Years	20 Credits

World Language	1 Year	5 Credits
Physical Education/Health	4 Years	20 Credits

Tech. Lit., Career Ed., Life Skills	1 Year	5 Credits

In addition, all students must meet the minimum standard on each section of the High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA) or its equivalent. Minimum passing scores are set by the New Jersey State Department of Education.

HONORS/AWARDS

- Holmdel High School ranks among the most competitive high schools in the state. In September 2008 New Jersey Monthly Magazine ranked Holmdel High School number eleven (11) in the state of New Jersey, and number one (1) in Monmouth County.
- The class of 2009 included one (1) National Merit Scholar, thirteen (13) finalists and thirty-nine (39) commended students in the 2009 National Merit Scholarship competition.
