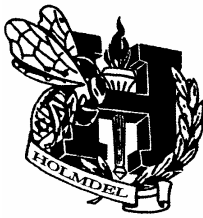
STUDENT RULES CONSENT AND UNDERSTANDING

WASHINGTON TRIP POINT SYSTEM

In accordance with the policy established by the staff and administration from W.R. Satz School specifically, a point system exists. The point system helps to assure that all students obey the school rules and regulations and respects the legitimate authority of the school, its teachers and administrators.

CONDUCT REPORT POINT SYSTEM

1. Warning (oral) – no points assessed/Warning (written) – 1 point per conduct report
2. Lunch detentions – 1 point assessed
3. Detentions (Office/Teacher) – 1 point assessed per day
4. ISS – 2 points assessed per day
5. OSS – 2 points assessed per day
6. Referral to Guidance Dept. – 1 point assessed
7. Referral to SRO (School Resource Officer) – 2 points assessed
8. Referral to Central Office – 2 points assessed

ATTITUDE POINT SYSTEM

1. Any N (Needs Improvement) or U (Unsatisfactory) in the attitude section of the student's report card adds one (1) Washington Trip point to their record.
2. Any of the following comments reported on a student's progress report or report card will add one (1) Washington Trip point (per comment) onto their record:

- #53 – Unconcerned with personal progress
- #55 – Inappropriate behavior/attitude
- #57 – Needs to cooperate better with teacher and/or peers
- #63 – Often inattentive/does not follow directions in class
- #65 – Careless with materials/equipment/safety rules
- #69 – Unprepared with books, material, etc.

ACCUMULATION OF (10) TEN POINTS

Upon committing the tenth discipline or attitude point, or any combination thereof, an administrative conference, conducted at the discretion of the administration, will be held between the parent/guardian(s), student, Counselor and Principal for a complete review of the student's school activities at that time. The student will then remain on a probationary status and the student's participation in extra-curricular activities such as school dances, athletic events, plays and concerts and other activities will be evaluated and can be denied to the student at the Principal's discretion.

ACCUMULATION OF (15) FIFTEEN POINTS

Upon the accumulation of fifteen or more discipline or attitude points, or any combination thereof, students forfeit their right to participate in any school trip, event, activity or function. This includes but is not limited to, removal from the Washington, D.C. trip, non-participation in beach day or any other end of the year field-day event, or denial of admittance to school dances, parties, and social events.

POINT REDUCTION (APPLIES TO CONDUCT REPORT POINTS ONLY)

In an effort to reinforce positive behavior, a student may reduce his or her discipline point record by one (1) discipline point every (30) thirty days of appropriate behavior displayed, meaning that no conduct reports have been submitted AND on any and all report cards/progress reports issued during that time, no negative attitude marks have been reported as well.

Detentions and detention packets: If the student completes the scheduled detention along with a learning packet, a point reduction will occur. Point reductions are only given for the successful completion of the learning packet. Please note that a students' record can not be reduced below zero.

Please note:

*Although parents have the right to request scheduling a meeting with the administration in order to review their child's record (and discuss the results thereof), the school reserves the right to take any action deemed necessary in order to carry out or prevent interference with the educational function. **Alternative assessments and accommodations will be made in lieu of all curriculum-based field trips, events or activities.***
