#### 1. Bowne-Crawford House – Feasibility Study

Spiezle Architects presented the feasibility study that was completed on the Bowne-Crawford House and reviewed the options available for consideration.

## 2. Health Benefits Update

Brown and Brown Insurance, the district health benefits advisor, presented on the history of the SEHBP, the current SEHBP premium increases and estimated increases for the 2023/2024 budget year.

# 3. Multipurpose Turf Field Project Update

### 4. 2021/2022 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR) Update

PKF O'Connor Davies will be attending the March committee meeting to provide an update regarding this matter and will present at the 3/29/23 board meeting.

### 6. 2022/2023 Professional Service Providers

The committee reviewed the current professional service providers and discussed the annual renewal/approval process.

## 7. 2022/2023 Nonpublic School Aid

This represents state aid provided to the nonpublic schools located within the Township. The District acts as a flow through entity, whereas the state distributes the aid to the District and then the District distributes the funding to the applicable nonpublic schools located in Holmdel. This aid is for Chapter 192/193 services and the applicable resolution is included on the 2/15/23 agenda for approval.
