World Language Level 4 – The Committee discussed the needs of high school students in the area of world language. We currently offer a fourth year of a language only as an honors course. This does not meet the needs of all of our students some of whom would take a fourth year if it was offered as a regular course. Not right now, but perhaps two years from now, we would like to plan to offer a fourth year of at least one world language.

Algebra I, Grade 7 Math – The committee discussed and supports Algebra I being offered in the seventh grade. Data collected from the past few years indicates that we have and will continue to have a select group of students who would benefit from taking this course in seventh grade. Placement criteria was developed by administrators and math teachers. As a result, the mathematics criteria will be modified to reflect the additional course in the program studies.

Academic Integrity Policy- The Committee was presented with a draft of an Academic Integrity Policy for Holmdel High School for review. It will be discussed at a later meeting.
