## WAIVER OPPORTUNITY AND REQUIREMENTS

- Initial placement into an Honors course for rising 6th, 7th, and 8th graders necessitates that students earn 6 or more points on our 8-point criteria scale, with the exception of placement into Honors Algebra I from 6th grade honors. Criteria includes standardized state assessments, standardized district assessments, classroom grades, and writing samples.
- Once placed in Honors, students must maintain a class average of 86 or higher to remain in the Honors level for the subsequent school year.
- Waivers for rising 6th, 7th, and 8th graders will be considered if a student earns a score of 4 or 5 points on our 8-point scale. Students with scores of 1-3 points will not be eligible to waive into advanced courses.
- For rising 9th graders, students will be recommended to courses based on the grades earned the prior school year. At the time of scheduling, students may elect to take courses in which they are not recommended, therefore necessitating a waiver.
- All waiver students must have signed parent permission.
- All waiver students must complete additional summer prerequisite work by July 31. If a student has not completed the additional summer prerequisite work by July 31, their waiver will be revoked and they will be placed into the recommended course as determined by the above criteria.
- All students, especially waiver students, are actively encouraged to attend extra help sessions during the school year.

Waivers will not be accepted after July 15, 2024.
