A. Call to Order

The Board of Education, Township of Holmdel, met in a Regular Business Meeting on Wednesday, May 4, 2022 remotely and at Holmdel High School, 36 Crawfords Corner Road, Holmdel, New Jersey. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mrs. Urbanski, Board President.

- The board vests in its president, or other presiding officer, authority to terminate the remarks of any individual if he/she deems it in the best interest of those present to do so.

Basketball coach process - As the employer, through both the procedures and processes which a district follows with regard to personnel matters, formal inquiries, and investigations, every effort is made to proceed discreetly and in strict adherence to the confidentiality of those proceedings. This particular case is no different and therefore, as superintendent of schools I'm unable to provide specific details about this case nor respond to claims and assertions which may have been presented in the local media. I can however speak in terms of the procedures and protocols which a district will follow in these cases and which were followed in this particular case.

When the district is in receipt of what can be characterized as a public complaint or grievance, there are a number of different policy mechanisms by which this complaint/grievance may be addressed and or investigated. In some cases, and pursuant to Board of Education policy and or statute and administrative code, the district may be obliged to turn the allegation or complaint over to local law-enforcement and or county prosecutor's office. While the respective law-enforcement agency is engaging in their own investigation, the school district's investigation must be paused. Only once the school district has been officially informed by the aforementioned law enforcement agency that they have concluded their investigation and presented the disposition in that investigation, may the school district commence its own internal inquiry process.

Once the district receives that disposition, the internal investigation proceeds and is concluded in an expedient but at the same time diligent process as possible. While bringing appropriate closure to the investigation in a timely manner as possible is, generally speaking, in the best interest of all parties, it is also worth noting that investigations and corresponding interviews, analysis of findings, and presentation of findings in the form of a written report can sometimes require a significant investment of time.
